**Opening of a Dialysis Clinic in Cotia, Brazil, Compatible with the Public Healthcare System
— Contributing to Improved Healthcare Access and the Resolution of Social Issues
in Regional Cities —**

GSI Creos Corporation (Head Office: Minato-ku, Tokyo; President & CEO: Tadaaki Yoshinaga) has opened a dialysis clinic in the city of Cotia, São Paulo State, Brazil, that is compatible with the country's public healthcare system (SUS: Sistema Único de Saúde) in partnership with RENAL BRASIL PARTICIPAÇÕES LTDA. An opening ceremony for the facility was held on April 27, 2026.

This facility marks the first dialysis clinic in Cotia and was established in response to requests from the city government and local health authorities. It will provide hemodialysis treatment to approximately 300 dialysis patients residing in Cotia, enabling those who had previously been compelled to make lengthy trips to neighboring cities to receive continuous dialysis care within their own community, and is expected to significantly improve access to medical care.

The opening ceremony was attended by over 100 guests, including the Mayor of Cotia, the Director of the City Health Department, other stakeholders, and residents, underscoring the high expectations placed on this initiative to strengthen the regional healthcare infrastructure. The event also attracted coverage from local media outlets, which have widely reported on the facility as a vital piece of infrastructure development for the local community.

GSI Creos has been operating four dialysis clinics with local partners under the name of “GSI Creos Memorial Clinic” in Brazil since 2021. While this clinic represents the fifth dialysis facility established by the GSI Creos Group, it differs from our previous facilities in that its primary objective is to provide medical services to citizens utilizing Brazil’s public healthcare system (SUS), rather than relying on private medical insurance. This initiative also holds significant value as an example of a Japanese company collaborating with a local government to provide medical services within the public healthcare sector in a sustainable manner.

In recent years, Brazil has faced challenges regarding the rising number of patients suffering from chronic renal failure and disparities in healthcare access; in particular, a shortage of dialysis services in regional cities has been identified as a critical issue. This facility serves as a concrete response to these social challenges, contributing to the maintenance of residents' health and the improvement of their quality of life.

Moving forward, our Group remains committed to contributing to the realization of a sustainable society by developing healthcare infrastructure tailored to the specific needs of various countries and regions.
